#### **1. Case Scenario**

A 38-year-old school teacher presents with recurrent migraine for six months. The headaches which is left sided are throbbing, begin in the morning, are aggravated in crowded classrooms and by noise, and are relieved by lying down in a dark, quiet room. She washes her face with ice cold water during the attack. She is irritable, oversensitive to noise, and craves cold drinks during attacks. Sleep is disturbed due to anxiety about work responsibilities. Menses are regular but accompanied by low backache. She experienced grief two years ago after the death of a close family member. On examination, pupils are normal, and there are no neurological deficits. She appears pale, tired, and anxious.

Based on the above clinical scenario of migraine, answer the following:

- (a) Describe the essential principles of case-taking in Homoeopathy as elaborated by Dr. Hahnemann with reference to the signs and symptoms.( 6 marks)
- (b) Outline the method of conducting a complete examination and investigations of the patient in the context of migraine. (4 marks)
- (c) Analyse the case by identifying Generals, common and characteristic

symptoms and discuss the hierarchy of symptoms and explain the principles of individualization relevant to this case. (3+3)

(d) Summarize how the totality of symptoms would be constructed for this migraine case and what will be the Homoeopathic management plan (4 marks)
