ABSTRACT

KUHS-Academic-Nursing- B.Sc. Nursing- Request to consider conducting a supplementary examination for the fourth semester- Recommendation of the Sub-Committee- Implemented subject to ratification by the Academic Council - Orders issued.

ORDER

1) Clause 1.18 of B.Sc Nursing Course Regulations (2021-22 Academic Year onwards) stipulates that *The candidate should clear all the previous University examinations before appearing for university examinations in Fifth Semester and before appearing for university examinations in Seventh Semester* and KUHS BSC Nursing Syllabus (2021-22 Academic Year onwards) stipulates that *Regular University examinations will be conducted at the end of each Semester. Supplementary examinations shall be conducted along with the End Semester University examinations. However, for ensuring the supplementary chances for failed students, University examinations of different subjects shall not be scheduled on the same date. A student who failed in a subject/ subjects may be permitted to reappear in the subsequent end semester university examination.*

2) An agenda was placed before the 37th Academic Council held on 11.06.2024 by Dr. Roy K George, Academic Council Member, requesting to consider conducting a supplementary examination for B.Sc. Nursing 4th semester students who have failed to clear the examinations.

3) The matter was discussed in detail by the Academic Council and vide paper read as (1) above, decided to constitute a sub-committee with Pro Vice Chancellor (Chairman), Dean (Nursing) and Dean (Academic) as members to study the matter and to submit report.

4) Accordingly, the meeting of the sub-committee was conducted on 28.06.2024. It was noted that only 448 of the 7016 students have failed in the 4th Semester B.Sc. Nursing Examination which amounts to only 6.3 %. It was also observed that conducting an additional examination in B.Sc. Semester system is not feasible. The committee further suggested that students who are pending to appear for 5th semester University exams due to backlogs may be permitted to appear for 6th semester Regular Examinations; by this,

the academic progression of students is ensured and they get chance to clear the backlogs before appearing for 7th semester Regular University Examinations.

5) Accordingly, vide paper read as (2) above, the following recommendations were submitted:

- To follow the B.Sc. Regulations as such and suggested that students can be permitted to appear for 6th semester University Regular Examinations irrespective of their previous semester backlog.
- To not conduct additional Supplementary examinations for the the B.Sc. Nursing Course (Semester Scheme)

In the circumstances, considering that the 5th semester regular examinations are scheduled and a decision is to be taken by the university, sanction is hereby accorded to accept the recommendations of the sub-
